

An alarming 14 million of young Europeans aged between 15 and 24, regardless of their education level, are disengaged from both work and education and therefore at a higher risk of labor market and social exclusion. The situation of unemployed NEETs (Not in Education, Employment, or Training) is particularly alarming in Spain, Romania and Greece.

Empowering young people by creating favorable conditions for them to develop their skills and to work and participate actively in society is essential for sound and sustainable economic and social development and for improving their wellbeing so that they can engage, achieve and flourish.


